Brings together difference makers from across Canada to collaborate on advancing knowledge, practice, and research in post-secondary student mental health.

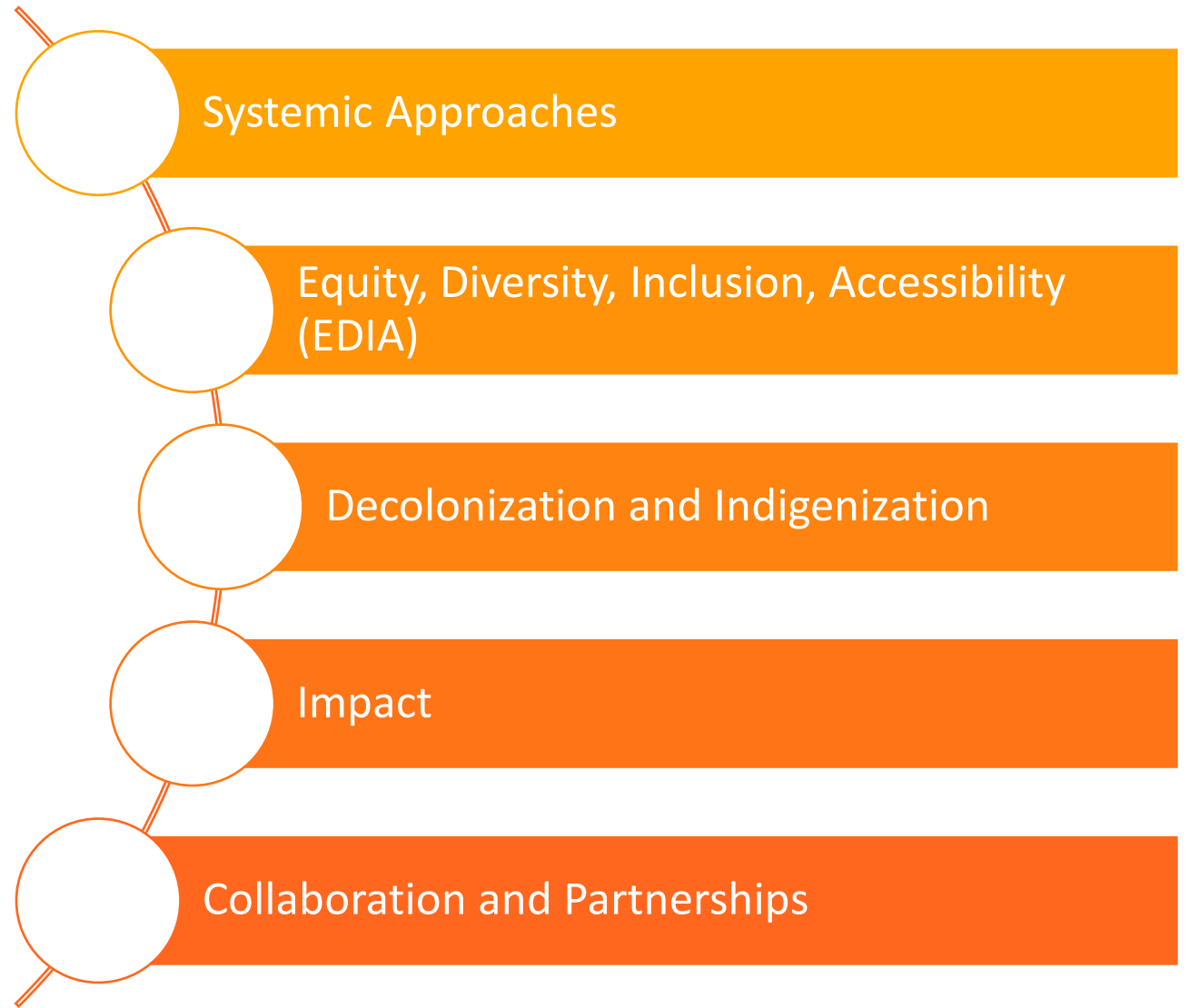

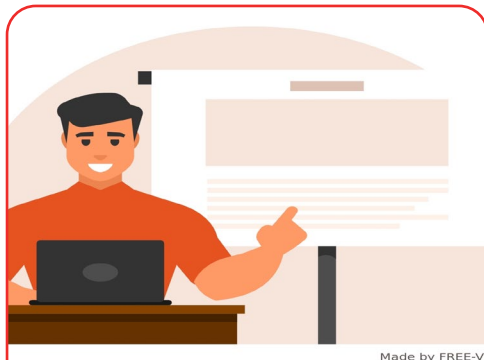

Strategy and Collaboration

Strategic alignment to conference focus areas, national standards, research and best practices, and describes collaboration and engagement with post-secondary mental health community.
(Includes consideration and integration of EDIA)

Impact and Application

Impact and application to the field of post-secondary mental health.
(e.g., How does content contribute to field of post-secondary mental health? How can content be applied? What impact does content have on target population? What outcomes are expected?)

Proposal Design and Learning

Clear description and value for learners
(e.g., learning objectives, participant engagement)
